

Downloading an eBook Using Your Kindle Fire

All steps may be performed on the Kindle Fire.

To connect to a wireless network:


1. 1st generation Kindle Fire: Tap the **Quick Settings** icon (looks like a gear) in the upper right corner.



2nd generation (or newer) Kindle Fire: Swipe down from the top of the device to access the Quick Settings menu options.

2. Tap **Wi-Fi** or **Wireless**.
3. Tap **ON**.
4. If your Kindle Fire does not automatically connect to a wireless network, select the appropriate network from the list.

To check out and download a Kindle Book:

1. From the Home screen, tap **Web** to open the web browser.
 2. Enter **amazon.com** in the address bar at the top and tap **Go**.
 3. Sign in to the Amazon.com website. (If you do not sign in first, you may encounter additional steps not included in this handout.)
 4. Navigate to the OverDrive Digital Downloads website. (Enter **mymcpl.org** in the address bar, tap **Go**, tap **Books, Movies, Music**, tap **eBooks**, and tap the green **OverDrive Digital Downloads** button.)
 5. Select a title to check out. To verify that the book is available in Kindle format, tap the title of the book or the cover art to display item details.
 6. Tap the **Borrow** button.
 7. Sign in to the OverDrive Digital Downloads website.
 8. Tap  to go to your **Loans** page to view the item in your Loans.
 9. Tap the **Download** button, tap **Kindle Book**. Note: If Kindle Book is not a format choice, you can select Return to return the item.
 10. The Amazon website opens in a new tab. You will see a green box on the right side of the page with a “Deliver to” dropdown menu. Select the device to which you would like the title transferred from the menu and tap the **Get library book** button.
 11. Tap the **Home** icon. The book should display on the Home screen, and you should be able to open it and begin reading.
- Note: If the book does not display on the Home screen, access **Quick Settings**. Tap **Sync** or tap **Settings** and **Sync All Content**.
